

ITEX 2015 to showcase more than 1,000 inventions

KUALA LUMPUR: The International Invention & Innovation Exhibition (ITEX) 2015 will be held from May 21-23 at the Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre.

Malaysian Invention and Design Society (MINDS) president and founder Professor Tan Sri Dr Augustine Ong Soon Hock said the event had grown from merely 50 inventions when it first started to more than a thousand inventions today.

ITEX 2015 will showcase more than one thousand inventions from over 20 countries. It is a one-stop centre designed to appeal to the younger as well as professional crowds with numerous exciting concurrent exhibitions and seminars.

Held concurrently with ITEX are the Malaysian Young Inventors Exhibition (MYIE) 2015 and Asian

Young Invention (AYIE) 2015 exhibitions, which provide the platform for young inventors aged 20 years old and below to showcase their winning innovations, as well as allowing these youths to meet like-minded young inventors and their mentors from around the world.

MYIE 2015 will see up to 10 top winners from the national-level Malaysia Young Inventors Competition competing in AYIE 2015, where inventions will be showcased to an international audience.

Co-located with ITEX is the National Innovation Conference and Exhibition, which will carry the theme "Beyond Innovation".

The event will include conferences, exhibition, sales of the research and development products, product demonstrations and business matching sessions as well as honouring those who have achieved remarkable excellence in innovation in Malaysia through various innovation awards.
